

About Lynn Jae Marsh

Lynn Jae Marsh is the nom de plume and alter ego—indeed, the better half—of Lynn Jenkins. She was educated at Boston University, receiving her baccalaureate summa cum laude with distinction. At Boston University, she was the Rhodes scholar nominee and a member of Phi Beta Kappa (junior year nomination). She graduated from Boston University School of Law in 1981 with honors. Since graduation, she has practiced law in greater New Haven, in both the state and federal courts.

A hopeless dreamer, Lynn started reading romance novels when she was fourteen. One of her fondest memories is hopping on the Green Line to downtown Boston on Saturday mornings to buy an armful of Georgette Heyer paperbacks at Macy's Department Store. In 1991, she fell in love with Macintosh computers, web design, and the internet, and her e-publishing was the natural result.

Lynn lives in a tiny apartment in New Haven, Connecticut, surrounded by books and more books. She is fond of saying that a room without books is like a Mac without a soul. A long-term Connecticut resident, her interests include reading Shakespeare, working on her Macintosh computers (lovingly known as her "BabyMacs"), and studying English history. She is committed to the welfare of Connecticut children. In her professional career, she has served as counsel and



guardian ad litem for minors and has protected their interests in trust and estate cases. Her personal goals include free-lance writing, publishing commercial and literary fiction, and writing a treatise on sexual harassment in employment. She is presently working on her next novel, entitled *Two-Fifths*, a literary piece set in Pomfret, Connecticut in 1800. However, she will never put aside her love of romance, and is

researching a new fantasy novel where a vengeful, medieval sorceress transforms the handsome hero into a gargoyle as punishment for his transgressions. When not writing, Lynn promotes this ezine—which she designed and constructed herself using hand-coded XHTML, CSS, and JavaScript and original Photoshop and Illustrator artwork. She is also skilled in GoLive, QuickTime, Acrobat, Word, BBEdit, Flash, PowerPoint, and all major browsers. Recently, she used these skills to co-found *Lightning Strikes: A Writers Community*, an online critique community with open cyber doors at Yahoo Groups. She designed both web sites, as well as her professional page at homepage.mac.com/lynn_jenkins.html, with the intent to improve the usability of the internet for the sight-impaired and the disabled.

The winner of the citywide Gwendolyn Brooks Poetry Prize (third place) for the year 2001 and several *Romantic Times* contests, Lynn has self-published two booklets for children: *The Handbook on Custody Cases* and *The A, B, C's of Divorce*. Her ezine, which has received high praise from her many readers, logs in over 4,000 hits per month. *Romantic Days*, *Romantic Nights* (Liquid Silver
